

How to view the PROMPT Log Data Set under Linux

1. You must be on the console and using Alt F3 with the Linux prompt.
2. You should be at \$ prompt. Type `cd /edx` and press enter.
3. Next type `vi + virlog.txt` and press enter
The + says to go to the end of the file. To view from the front omit the +.
If you get an empty data set you are not in /edx.
4. Use the page up and page down keys to view the log.
5. To search for a pattern, for example you want to see how often a program such as #BOPENT has been loaded. Be sure you are in the command mode. Then type in the command line `/BOPENT` and press enter. This will take you to the first time it is recorded in the log file, and each time you type `n` (for next) and press enter, you will go to the next time this text is recorded in the log file.
6. When finished viewing the file press Shift `:q` to quit.
