

How to set products for delete based on date of last sale

There is a procedure to delete obsolete inventory products by putting an ! in the ABC code, then run the Inventory Master file purge (IC 4, 6).

If you want to mark any inventory master records for purge based on date of last sale the following PROMPT process will accomplish this task.

In the example below we are marking all product master records for delete that have a date last sold of less than 01/01/04.

Go to **PD** and chose **FG**.

Complete the screen as follows:

1. Data File SDNAME.....: (**INPROFLE**)
2. Flag Field Number: (**40**)
3. Flag Value.....: (**!**)
4. Conditional Field Number: (**29**)
5. Conditional Operator: (**<**)
6. Conditional Value.....: (**01/01/04**)

Before you press enter check the screen VERY CAREFULLY.

After you run and it reaches 100% you need to go to IC 5, 6 and check a few products that you expect the ABC code to now have an ! just to be sure you did the above process correctly.

At this point you have not yet run the purge, you have only marked master records to be purged. If everything looks okay you are ready to run the actual purge at IC, 4, 6 BUT be sure to run it after working hours.

Remember, if any product marked for purge has on hand or on order stock the record will not be purged.
