

**Problem - I want to purge all data out of the system about an employee and I don't care about historical stuff I want to get rid of this employee's data!**

Solution - You are responsible to be sure there are no current year transactions involving this employee, then do this!

- Select PD, then FP.

- Conditional Field Number.: ( 5 )
- Conditional Operator.....: ( = )
- Conditional Value .....: ( ???? ) Where ???? = The employee number of the employee you wish to purge.

Run File Purge Again like this:

- Select PD, then FP.
- Data file name.....: ( PRLTCFLE )
- Conditional Field Number.: ( 4 )
- Conditional Operator.....: ( = )
- Conditional Value .....: ( ???? ) Where ???? = The employee number of the employee you wish to purge.

At this point you can go to PR, 1 then go to option 2 and delete pay transactions, if any for such employee, and finally go to option 1 and delete the employee record.
